## VIRGINIA FALLS DAY TOUR JUNE TO MID SEPTEMBER

Soar over canyons while your floatplane pilot shares legends of the past. Keep an eye out for wildlife racing over the ground below. As you circle to land on the South Nahanni River, at the top of Virginia Falls, you'll see and hear powerful whitewater plunging 92 meters into the Painted Canyon below. There is no shortage of picturesque photo locations at this spectacular natural wonder. A short stop at the Nahanni Mountain Lodge on the way back to Fort Simpson will allow you to relax on the sandy beach.

## GLACIER LAKE DAY TOUR JUNE TO MID SEPTEMBER

This journey starts as the Virginia Falls Day Tour and then continues into the newly expanded Nahanni National Park Reserve. You will fly over the astonishing Cirque of the Unclimbables, a group of several cirques with 9000' peaks that drain into Glacier Lake. A brief stop allows you to take in the spectacular view of Mt. Harrison Smith – one of the highest mountains in the Ragged Range. A stop at the Nahanni Mountain Lodge to relax and enjoy the scenery completes the tour before flying back to Fort Simpson.

## MOOSE RIVER FISHING CHARTER JUNE TO MID SEPTEMBER

Get ready for some of the best fishing in the world. The remote and clear waters of this region are typically only seen by a small amount of people per year. Generally speaking, fish are more plentiful at Moose River after the spring thaw, around June. You will be required to bring all your gear and necessities, as there are no services at this location. For your safety, our pilot and plane will stay with you up to 4 hours, or until you are ready to return to Fort Simpson.

- **Starting at \$850.00 + GST** (Cessna 206)  
(net rate for tour wholesalers and receptive tour operators)
- Price is based on the cost per flight, not per person
- Fishing gear is available for rent
- Includes air transportation to/from Fort Simpson
- Visitors between the ages of 16 and 65 require a NWT fishing license
- Maximum four passengers in Cessna 206 (C-206).

## OVERNIGHT STAYS JUNE TO MID SEPTEMBER

Nahanni Mountain Lodge is that remote, private, wilderness paradise you've been looking for. Marvel at pristine waters right at your front door that shimmer from the base of the Nahanni Mountain Range, just outside the Nahanni National Park Reserve. The warm, shallow water and the expansive sandy beach are great for swimming and sunbathing. This newly renovated and expanded lodge is 60 miles west of Fort Simpson, accessible only by our floatplanes in the summer. Spend your time exploring the lake or fishing for Pickerel, Northern Pike, Lake Trout and Arctic Grayling.

- **Starting at \$580.00 + GST per person** (Based on 4 ppl)  
(net rate for tour wholesalers and receptive tour operators)
- Can sleep up to 12 people comfortably
- Includes return air transportation from Fort Simpson
- Motorboats and canoes provided for use during your stay
- Optional tour packages can be added to your stay
