Fly to Tuktoyaktuk on the coast of the Arctic Ocean to experience Inuvialuit Culture. You will visit some very unique sites such as the Pingos

and community Ice House. Discover the rich culture and history of this small Inuvialuit community.

A boat tour will allow you to explore the many creeks and channels of the spectacular Mackenzie Delta. Look for wildlife, do some bird watching and enjoy the serenity of the wilderness. Fishing can be arranged as well.

WINTER

Experience the magic of winter in the Arctic. Take a guided drive on an Ice Road and visit the community of Aklavik to see the gravesite of the famous Mad Trapper. Or let us drive you to the Inuvialuit community of Tuktoyaktuk.

Snowmobile tours can be an exhilarating way to explore the surrounding areas. Your local guide will take you over the frozen landscape of the Mackenzie Delta. In April, the Beaufort Delta livens up with carnivals in each of the communities. Many traditional games and customs can be observed.

ARCTIC COAST HISTORICAL TOUR

JUNE 20 TO MID SEPTEMBER

Visit Inuvik and enjoy the land of the midnight sun with our 4 nights, 3 days tour package. Tour Canada's most northerly town where your local guide will explain the history and culture of Inuvik and show you various sights, including the iconic Igloo church. Also enjoy our exclusive Tuktoyaktuk Delta cruise where you will boat from Inuvik to the Arctic Ocean and the community of "Tuk". Here you will get a chance to dip your toe in the Arctic Ocean, visit the community freezer and see Canada's National Landmark, Pingos before your 45 minute flight back to Inuvik for the night.

TUKTOYAKTUK DELTA CRUISE

JUNE 20 TO MID SEPTEMBER

This covered jetboat tour will usher you through the creeks and channels of the stunning Mackenzie Delta. Stop at Reindeer Station, established in 1932, where reindeer farming was introduced to Northern Canada. Keep an eye open for wildlife, flocks of migrating birds, and belugas (seasonal) on your way to Tuktoyaktuk. The magnificent landscape is dotted by more than 1500 ice-dome pingos. In Tuktoyaktuk your guide will share stories and history of the area. See the Lady of Lourdes schooner, a traditional sod house, the Hamlet's churches, and the Trans Canada Trailhead site. Take the opportunity to dip your toe in the Arctic Ocean!
