Yellow Dog Lodge is located between beautiful Duncan and Graham Lakes, only a 15 minute floatplane ride northeast of Yellowknife, Northwest Territories, Canada. The lodge features great sport fishing, brilliant opportunities for outdoor adventure and knowledgeable friendly staff. The lakes and streams offer the finest Lake Trout, Northern Pike and Arctic Grayling in the region. The natural beauty of the Northern Canadian Wilderness is pristine and we are committed to providing you with the best of nature and ensuring the same for those who follow. In this land where you can still drink water straight from the lakes, our guests have the opportunity to participate in a wilderness experience of a lifetime.

The location of the lodge is simply stunning. Situated right in between a narrow channel that connects Duncan and Graham Lakes, the lodge is surrounded by a dramatic landscape that is quite mountainous in

appearance. The Canadian Shield here is elevated more than normal and very rugged. This adventure lodge offers more than just fishing. Canoeing, kayaking, boating, hiking and wildlife viewing are also available. The area has beautiful beaches, amazing views and plenty of water to play in – there is something for everyone. Later in the season when the days are shorter, the Aurora Borealis fills the night sky and brings dramatic closure to the day's fishing. Our wood fired hot tub is the best place to watch these spectacular light displays.

Our fly-out trips to Yellow Dog Lodge vary in length from 2 to 7 days. Open mid-June through mid-September, guests can enjoy all the comforts of home in an incredible landscape. 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FLOATING WILDERNESS IN A MOVABLE BASE CAMP

JUNE TO SEPTEMBER

Experience the freedom to choose your own little spot of the wilderness - set up camp at the spot of your choosing with this unique tent camp floating on a pontoon barge. There is no better opportunity to fish around the clock with the midnight sun illuminating your catch and you certainly won't get any closer to the fish than this. This tent camp includes single beds, a woodstove, BBQ, a sink and refrigerator and comes with a 16 foot boat and motor which allows you to establish base camp and move about

the lakes. You have everything at your fingertips so that you can keep casting your line for as long as you want.

- Minimum of 5 nights
- 14' x 28' steel pontoon barge and wooden platform equipped with 15hp Honda engine (for moving the camp around the lakes).
